

FOLK DANCE INSTRUCTION SERIES

A series of 24 weekly instruction sessions in folk and square dance will be conducted by the Dayton Folk Dance Club, an organization sponsored by the Division of Recreation, at Burkhardt Community Center starting Tuesday, November 21, 1950. Sessions will be of 2 hours duration, every Tuesday 8:30 to 10:30 p.m., and will be set up in 2 semesters of 12 weeks each.

Registration fee will be \$4.50 per person per semester of 12 weeks. Registration must be in advance, and deadline for filing cards will be Friday, November 10. Registration card, together with \$4.50 fee, should be taken, or mailed, to the Division of Recreation, basement Municipal Building, Third & Ludlow Streets. Checks should be made payable to "Division of Recreation".

Emphasis in the entire series will be predominantly on folk dance, as distinguished from square dance. Some square dance instruction will be included, enough for dancers to be able to go through the basic figures, but this part of the instruction will be definitely secondary. Primary purpose will be to develop your skill and knowledge of folk dancing.

You may register for the series individually; however, if at all possible, dancers are urged to register as couples. This way everyone is assured a partner. Due to the limited floor space at Burkhardt Center, registration must be limited to 50.
