Want To Do-Si-Do? Recreation Bureau Slates Dance Lessons

The Dayton recreation bureau announced yesterday it will sponsor recreational dance lessons for adults beginning Oct. 1. Instruction will be given in square, folk and round dancing.

A square dance class at Webster school and a round dance class at Belle Haven school will be formed Oct. 1. Folk dance classes will begin at Burkhardt center Oct. 3.

Only registration by couples will be accepted for round and square dancing. But individuals may register for folk dance lessons, Michael Solomon, recreation director said.

The classes will be held each week from 8:30 to 10:30 p.m. for 12 weeks. Advance registrations taken at the recreation office, Municipal building basement.

Solomon said all classes will be for beginners, and will include fundamental steps, patterns and dances.

Square dance lessons will cover standard and popular figures and patterns. The general style will be western-type square dancing, Solomon explained, and classes will include singing and patter calling.

The folk dance class will feature popular dances of nations throughout the world. Basic steps, in-

cluding the waltz, two-step, polka and schottische, also will be taught, the recreation director said.
