Only after these funds have been exhausted, should the Council seek additional funds from the Clubs.

This quarter assessment was put into effect prematurely, and it is our feeling that future tariffs assessed should be done only after concrete plans for the new Pavilion have been solidified.

With the cost of labor and material skyrocketing, this money should be used for the immediate needs of the existing Pavilion -- not "stashed" away for a long period of time only to realize at some later date that the renovations we want to make are then beyond our reach.

This money was given by today's dancers and, therefore, today's dancers should be the ones to enjoy its benefits.
