Several years and many dances and meetings ago, Charley and Louise arrived on the Dayton Square and Round Dance scene. Since that time many good things have come to pass as a result of their hard work and dedication.

Charley and Louise now dance with the Dayton Square Dance Club, the Whirlaways, the Miami Valley Round Dance Club, and the Flairs. While serving on the Dayton Square Dance Club council in 1975 and 1976, they worked as program chairmen and reinstated the all-visiting caller format which resulted in the upgrading of dancing skills in that club.

The years 1977 and 1978 saw Charley and Louise serving all of the Miami Valley dancers when they were elected president of the Miami Valley Dance Council. During their two year term, the plans were made and the format originated for leadership seminars for newly elected club officers. Operation, finances, officer requirements, problem solving for new club officers were a part of the seminar plan.

Charley acted as a committee of one in presenting our plans for the Kittyhawk Dance Pavilion to the Dayton City Council. He spent many hours in meetings with Recreation Department officials, architects, city officials and planning board members in presenting views of square dancers. This work was recognized on February 25, 1979 when Charley was presented an award by the Mayor of Dayton for "outstanding volunteer services to the City of Dayton."

During this same period, Charley and Louise were serving as chairmen of the registration committee for the 20th Annual Buckeye Convention.

They now serve as Treasurer of the Michael Solomon Support Committee whose aim is to make dancing there as enjoyable as possible. The new ventilation system was the start.

When jobs are to be done and help to be given square and round dancing as needed, Charley and Louise will be there turning thoughts into action and accomplishment.
