Bud and Millie White took square dance lessons from Jerry Helt in 1983. After some medical problems kept both of them from dancing, they returned to classes and took their Plus lessons with the Double H Squares in 1986. They now belong to and regularly dance with both the Double H Squares and the Mainstreamers.

Both Bud and Millie are active club supporters. She was Secretary for the Matinee Mainstreamers for two years and served on the kitchen committee. They have been the Double H Squares Banner Chairmen for the past two years and now have credit for 125 Double H banner raids.

They served on the television committee for the Dayton Presentation at the Buckeye State Convention in Toledo in 1990 and are currently serving on the 1991 Buckeye State Convention Publicity Committee. In this capacity, they are in the process of making over 50 visits to square and round dance clubs in Ohio to promote the Dayton convention. They attend all the MVDC meetings, attended all but one of the "Day in the Park" promotions, and were asked to be on the MVDC float in the Paper festival. They have attended the past two "Heartbeat" leadership seminars sponsored by the MVDC.

Bud and Millie have danced at the last four Buckeye Square Dance Conventions, attended the National Convention in Indianapolis, and participated in the square dancing at the Ohio State Fair. They also attended the first World Square Dance Convention in Austria in 1987.

In addition to scheduling banner raids, they schedule club square dance demos. Some of the annual events include the 4th of July parade in Huber Heights, the Heritage Day Festival in New Carlisle, the North Dayton Days festival, and the Marigold Festival in Huber Heights. They also schedule entertainment demos for patients in the Montgomery County Developmental Home and the Glenwood (Alzheimer) Nursing home. They also award badges and danglers to Double H club members based on participation in these events. They "angel" on a regular basis (not just when scheduled) for the Double H Squares. She is one of the reporters for the monthly Double H Squares Newsletter.

In their spare time they have managed to acquire eight (8) MVDC Friendship badges, a state Friendship badge, have filled a Century Club book with over 100 callers' signatures, have twice attended the New Years Day Polar Bear Dance in Indiana, and spent a weekend at the English Mountain square dance resort. Bud and Millie will celebrate their 40th wedding anniversary in October.
