Kenneth and Annabelle Kiser are residents of Jamestown, Ohio. They began square dancing in 1960, with the hoedown. In 1972 they joined the Western square dance lesson class with Chuck Myers at the YMCA in Xenia. The Kisers were one of the founding couples and charter members of the Xenia Hospitality Western Square Dancers in 1973. They also took Al lessons under Jaye Fitch.

After the tornado in 1974, when space in Xenia was at a premium, they assisted in the search for new places to dance, since the club was forced to move several times.

Kenny and Annabelle have been willing workers for most of the Hospitality Squares' projects, including special dances, demonstrations at several of the area nursing homes, and building of floats for the parades of Xenia Old Fashioned Days, Spring Valley Potato Festival, and the Jamestown Bean Festival. They have also been angels for every lesson class sponsored by the Xenia Hospitality Western Square Dancers since its founding.

Offices held in the Hospitality Squares include Treasurer, 1978; Vice President, 1982; President, 1983.

The Kisers have also demonstrated support for our club by participating in banner raids and retrievals. As of December 31, 1990, each of them had 270 raids to their credit.

Kenny and Annabelle were voted "Sweethearts of the Hospitality Squares" in 1989.

The Kisers attended all of the State Square Dance Conventions which were held in Dayton, Cincinnati and Columbus between 1978 and 1985, as well as the National Convention in Indianapolis in 1986 and a weekend at Fontana, NC.
