This letter is in regards to the Miami Valley Dance Council meeting which was held on Tuesday, July 14, 1992. A letter written by the Miami Valley Round Dance Club was read at the meeting expressing concerns about the council meetings running longer than 8:30 p.m. and "eating" into the club's dance time. As a result of this, the club asked if council meetings could be moved to another night.

After discussing this matter with my supervisors, we would like for the council to know that it has our approval to continue holding meetings on Tuesday evenings as they have been in the past. We encourage the council to make every effort to end all meetings promptly at 8:30 p.m. If it is not possible to get through all of the agenda items in an hour and a half, then we recommend that the starting time of the council meetings be moved up to 6:45 p.m.

We feel that the Miami Valley Round Dance Club does have a valid concern. It would be disappointing to have to shorten dance time as a result of a meeting running overtime. Because the Michael Solomon Dance Pavilion is used seven nights a week, it is our feeling that this concern could potentially be raised on whatever night the council meetings are scheduled to be held. Therefore, we would like to emphasize again that the council should make every effort to keep all meetings within the allotted time frame.
