

YELLOW SPRINGS YELLOW ROCKERS

Leadership by Terry & Joretta Cox and Larry & Lous Acomb in 1984 led to a square dance class. The services of Jaye Fitch were obtained and lessons began. It was during the lessons the Yellow Springs Yellow Rockers were formed, complete with constitution, in December 1984.

The name of the club and badge symbol, ie: rock, was derived from the village name, square dance term, and the connection between the village and the local nature preserve, Glen Helen.

The Bryan Center was the site of the classes and dances. The dance location was moved to the high school gym/cafeteria in 1990 for a period of two years while the center was completely renovated. In late 1992 the club returned to a beautifully-remodeled, air conditioned center with a new hardwood dance floor.

The club has held an annual Fall Festival Dance for the past ten years at the high school or Michael Solomon Pavilion. Jaye Fitch has been our faithful club caller since the club's inception. Ralph & Melanie Acton, charter members, are current and active participants. Terry Cox is still active as an advisor as the Yellow Springs Recreation Director.
