

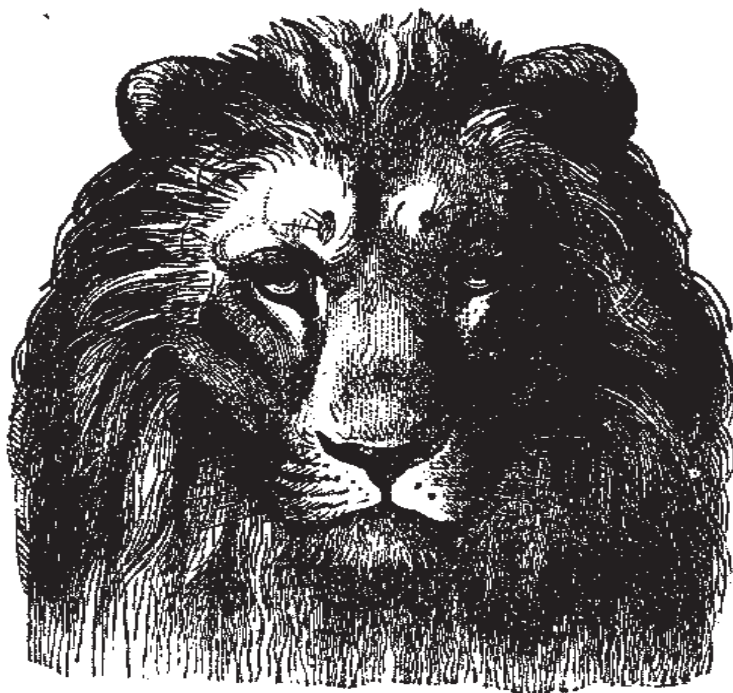

Committee Reports**Michael Solomon Support Chair**

Fellow Michael Solomon Pavilion Users,
 The Michael Solomon Support Committee had a busy year in 2004. The highlights for the year include: Building planter boxes on the southeast side of the Pavilion, the purchase of 10 lightly padded folding chairs, the purchase of 15 Mity-Lite tables, the start of a multi-year project to replace the overhead light fixtures with energy efficient fixtures, and the replacement of the drop ceiling in the woman's restroom.

The planter box is actually hiding a catch basin which is an attempt to prevent rain water run-off from going under the Pavilion. When the parking lot was redesigned several years ago, the city raised the grade level on the south side of the Pavilion by almost two feet making the top of the foundation below grade and piling dirt up

against the wooden siding. This is a perfect recipe for rotting out the wall and causing rain water to collect under the building. The planter box allows me to slope the ground towards the parking lot and catch water before it can seep under the Pavilion.

It has been many years since replacement tables and chairs were purchased and our existing tables and chairs are beginning to show their age. We had budgeted to have the floor refinished this last year. When I had Simpson Flooring evaluate the condition of the floor it was determined that it did not need re-finishing this year. I used this money to purchase the 15 new tables and 10 new chairs. During the spring clean up in 2005 I plan to retire several damaged tables.

On to the lights, for several years I have been repairing the light fixtures. I have also been aware that there was a federal mandate in the early 1990's to improve lighting efficiency in commercial and public buildings by 10%. Due to a number of reasons the Pavilion was overlooked during this program. The final straw came last spring after I had spent a couple of hours repairing one of the fixtures only to have the other half of it fail as soon as I turned it on. The cost of completely repairing one of the existing fixtures exceeds the cost of a new fixture complete with bulbs! The original fixtures take four 40-Watt bulbs and two 0.76-ampere ballasts. The new fixtures take four 32-Watt bulbs and one 0.93-ampere ballast. An energy savings of about 28% for each fixture replaced. I could tell you which fixtures have been replaced, but that would take all the fun out of it.

The drop ceiling in the woman's bathroom was replaced after Christmas and the expense will actually show up against the 2005 maintenance budget. The 16 inches of snow just before Christmas resulted in the closure of the pavilion for eight days as the roads and parking lot were not passable. The snow also resulted in some impressive ice dams on the Pavilion's roof. They were two to three feet in length up from the eaves

and three to four inches thick. This resulted in a lot of water backing up under the roofing and seeping into the pavilion, most notably in the kitchen, bathrooms, and along the porch. I expect that some of the tables in storage were water damaged. Hardest hit was the ceiling in the woman's restroom. It's amazing how much water those ceiling tiles can collect without failing. The four damaged tiles in the men's restroom were replaced and I replaced the entire ceiling in the woman's restroom. There are several ceiling tiles in the main hall that also need to be replaced.

The projects I have planned for next year are: Build planter boxes on the south-west side of the pavilion, continue the light fixture replacement, and have the floor refinished during the convention weekend in May.

With the fear of forgetting people, I would like to thank John Stocker for his support of repainting the doors, installing a new picture rail for the honor award pictures, and installing a new thermostat on the south-east heater; Sandy Gordon for cleaning the pavilion every week, Barb and Tom Dieterle for their decorations for the past few years (anyone want to try and fill their shoes?); Bill Vernon and Ed Anderson for being available on short notice to help with whatever and whenever I needed help; and Sharry Hayden for being the support committee treasurer. I apologize to those that I've missed, Fay Samborsky, Stuart Lewis, Patty Lindsey, Gary and Joyce Lindsey, Clarita Maples, and Steve Hayden to name a few, for their support.

One final note, anyone want to volunteer for the MSSC support committee chair? I'm more than ready to turn over the reigns to any willing volunteer.
