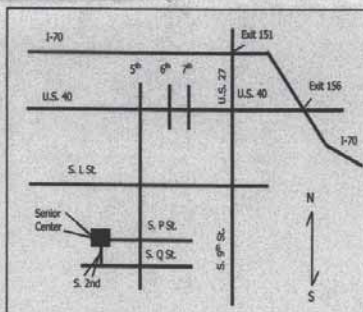

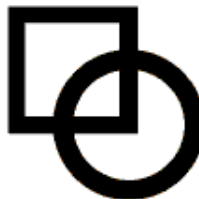

Rules For Angels

1. You can help most by setting a good example, by being a good listener, not talking when the teacher is talking and not attempting to teach. Chances are that when a problem pops up, the teacher already knows what has gone wrong. But, if you see something the teacher should be aware of, let him know so he can handle the situation with the new dancers, rather than you.

2. Convert your dancing to what the new dancers are learning. Stick with the style and standards that are being taught. We know this will be hard to do, but when you twirl the girls after a Courtesy Turn, swing Do SI Do, or bump during a Weave The Ring, it confuses the new dancer. They will have plenty of time to pick up all the extras and styling.

3. Your prime purpose as a helper is to ensure that all student dancers have an opportunity to dance. So if you see one of the class members sitting out, please see if they won't take your place in the square. Or if someone needs a partner, please step in and help.

4. Teachers sometimes make mistakes, and if he does, please don't correct him in front of the class. Wait for the break and bring it to his attention. He will appreciate it.

5. Remember every thing that disturbed you about angels when you were taking class: The looks, the remarks, and the squares that always stayed together. Try not to be one of those.

6. Always offer encouragement to the students in your square, even when it is going

very slow and the students are making mistakes.

7. When you are not dancing, keep the background talking to a low roar. This has been one of the major complaints of the students for many years. Many times they cannot hear the teacher because of people talking around the sidelines.

8. Being an angel is not something that is expected of you – it is a privilege. You are the people that the lesson class is watching. The instructor teaches the calls, but the Gem City dancers will teach them how to dance. Our best compliment will be: "We want to take classes with Gem City Squares."

9. Finally, a couple of "NEVERS". Never yank, or pull, or push one of the students into position. The object of the class is to get the dancers to think for themselves. Granted, it takes time and a great deal of patience, but it does pay off. Avoid talking when the teacher is instructing. It's easy to distract someone in a square and if you, as an experienced dancer, focus your attention on what is being said over the microphone, you will influence the newcomers to do the same.
